# Introduction

CHILOTA Home Care is a nonprofit organization that will be providing meals to our homebound elderly, disabled, and vulnerable.

Since 2022, I retired with my husband Obi Agbogidi Igwe Onyemanaogaeme Ajufoh and we have been in Asaba.

I have met many people and have taken time to learn about their needs. Currently, we are supporting some people young and old with little financial resources. (Eg, Mama Nkemamuna, Ngozi, Chukwuka Mordi, Ogbueshi Ikemefuna Ajufoh till his death.....) other financial aides for small business owners, school fees, hospital bills, medications, and many more.

I noticed that these people are not the only ones that need help. That is how CHILOTA HOME CARE FOUNDATION WAS CREATED.

As of early 2026, Nigeria's poverty rate has risen to approximately 63%, with about 139 million people living in poverty.

Delayed and unpaid pensions for retired workers are also rising to a record high.

Our elderly and disabled people are included.

Nigeria as a country is extremely difficult to survive but by the grace of God and your support we will do our best for our people.

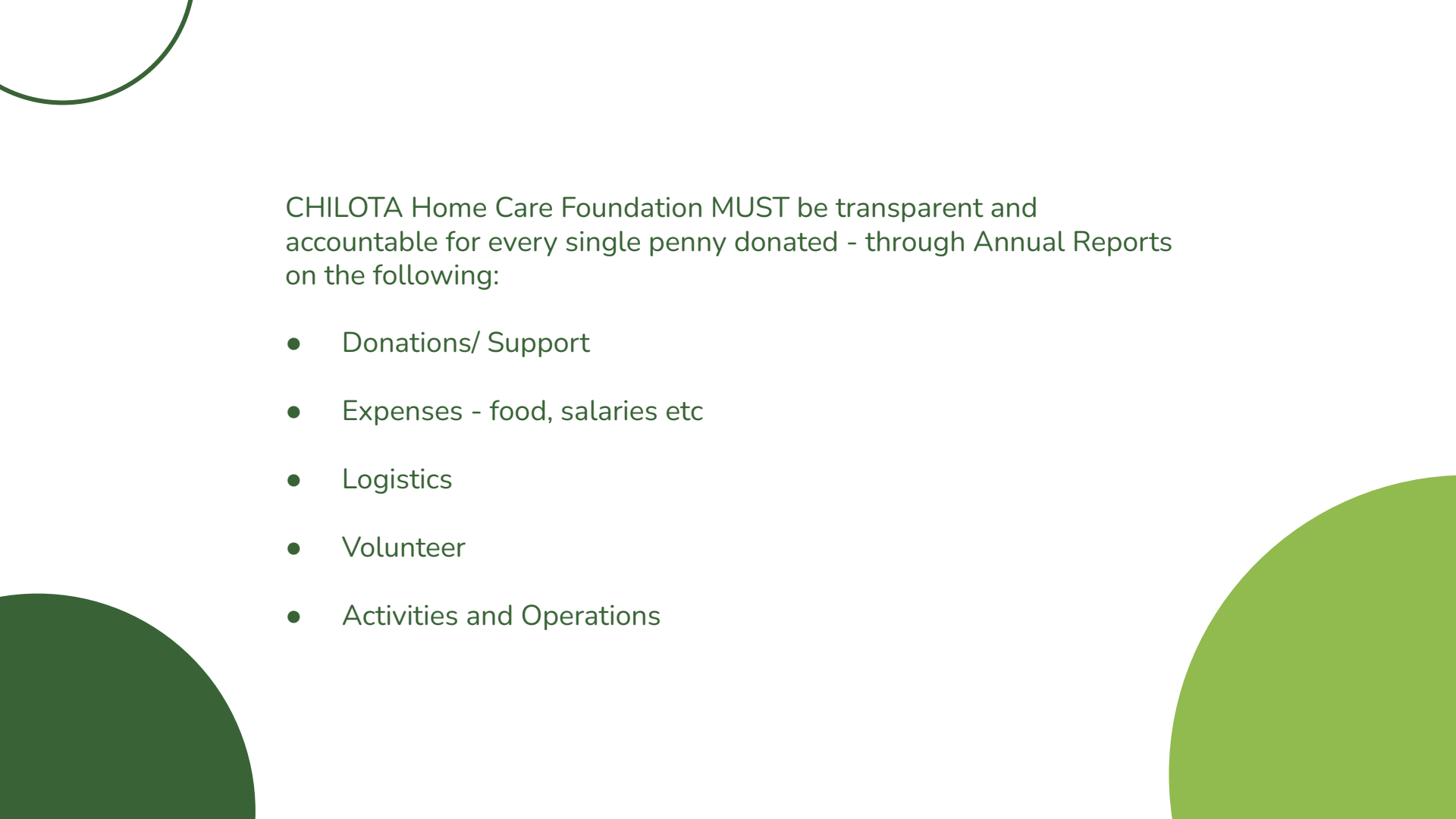

We are planning to launch the project/foundation in December 2026.

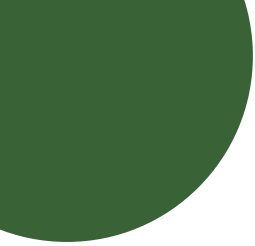
We will be working with ANA and every Asaba indigenes that have and will continue to support the project.
